To Our Valued Customers,


The purpose of this letter is to address concerns pertaining to our current raw material position and potential pricing actions.

Increasing world demand for resin and other downstream chemical components have resulted in significant cost pressure to our business. Though not directly tied to resin pricing, crude oil has soared to historic highs resulting in substantially higher energy, logistics and overhead costs.

As you may know, in an effort to counteract this growing cost pressure, Crane Composites deploys Six Sigma and Lean Manufacturing toward reducing operating costs. We continue to work with our key suppliers to minimize raw material increases.

Although this activity has generated favorable results, we continue to absorb cost increases beyond delivered efficiencies. We will continue to evaluate this developing situation and provide updates to you during the next several months.
